Dear Ms. Howland:

Enclosed for filing in the above-captioned docket are an original and six copies of the Member Incentive for New Hampshire Electric Cooperative Inc.'s CORE Energy Efficiency programs operated from January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014 as approved by the Commission in its Order No. 25,615 issued on December 30, 2013 in Docket No. DE 12-262.

The total earned incentive equals \$159,125, or 9% of actual expenditures. By sector, the portion of the budget resulting from performance in implementing the residential programs is \$110,831, or 9% of actual expenditures; performance in the commercial and industrial programs resulted in an incentive of \$48,294, or 7% of actual expenditures.

Also included is a report summarizing the difference between the total energy efficiency program funding and the expenses incurred in program year 2014. As shown, a balance of \$192,520 will be included in future CORE energy efficiency program year budgets.
