I understand that the question on the table is the Motion to Dismiss by PSNH. In that motion much weight was given to the issue of fairness to new customers and ratepayers. I think the only way to evaluate that fairness is in a public forum with information provided by PSNH about how many feet of Class 5 or higher roads remain unserved in their coverage area.
