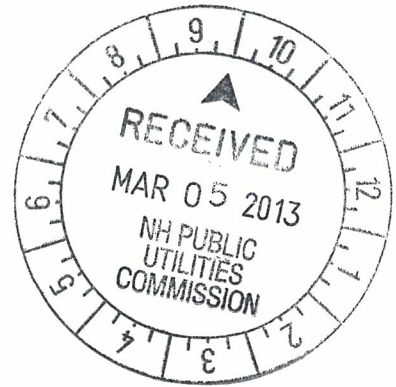

Jim Snyder's Request for Action on Motion
March 5, 2013



My Motion for Rehearing in docket 12-307 was filed on February 13, 2012. Twenty days have passed, fifteen of them business days, without action on this Motion. RSA 541:5 sets a limit of 10 days for action on a motion for rehearing:

541:5 Action on Motion. – Upon the filing of such motion for rehearing, the commission shall within ten days either grant or deny the same, or suspend the order or decision complained of pending further consideration, and any order of suspension may be upon such terms and conditions as the commission may prescribe.

As I mentioned in my letter of December 31, 2012, I am the only party in this matter negatively impacted by the passage of time. I request that the Commission act promptly so I can move ahead in the process.
