On June 11, 2012, Governor John H. Lynch signed into law New Hampshire Senate Bill 48 which, among other things, deregulated rates and charges for end user telecommunications services as of

August 10, 2012. Accordingly, FairPoint is withdrawing its NHPUC Tariff No.1 effective October 23, 2012, which will be filed under separate cover. The revisions in this NHPUC No. 2 Miscellaneous Network Services Tariff filing reflect language changes that are required as a result of the withdrawal of the NHPUC No. 1 Retail Tariff. FairPoint has developed a catalog of rates, terms and conditions for its products and services which resides at www.fairpoint.com. This document is labeled the "NH Catalog."

Included in this filing are changes to the Tariff consistent with the Orders of the Federal Communication Commission; See *Triennial Review Order* ("TRO"), 18 F.C.C.R. 16978 (2003) and the *Triennial Review Remand Order* ("TRRO") 20 F.C.C.R. 2533 (2005); and the ruling of the 1st Circuit Court of Appeals in *Verizon New England v. Maine Public Utilities Commission*, 509 F.3d 1 (1st Circuit 2007).
