Pursuant to activity in docket DT 12-337, this filing removes certain wire centers which FairPoint no longer asserts are non-impaired. The filing also provides for an additional 6 month transition period for the DS1 and DS3 interoffice transport between the offices that are still under investigation in Docket DT 12-337. Pursuant to the change to be made in this filing FairPoint will not charge any increased rate for the period January 15, 2013 to the effective date of this filing for the offices that are being removed. Additionally, FairPoint will not disconnect any DS1 and DS3 UNEs for the period from August 15, 2013 to the proposed effective date of this tariff.
