Dear Ms. Howland:

Enclosed please find the original and seven copies of the Petition for Approval of Refinancing of Existing Note / Past Due Amounts and Financing for 2012 Leach Field Rejuvenation and Vents on behalf of Bedford Waste Services Corp. ("Bedford" or "Company"). The filing includes the petition, direct testimony, financing schedules and the new promissory note. A copy of the filing has been provided to the Office of Consumer Advocate. A copy has also been provided to the board members of the homeowner association.

Bedford respectfully requests authority to borrow \$170,000 from its owner, Robert S. LaMontagne, over 15 years at a fixed interest rate of 8%. Approximately \$142,000 will be used to refinance the existing 2000 promissory note and \$28,000 will be used to finance a portion of the 2012 rejuvenation of a leach field and installation of vents and financing costs.
