Renewal Registration as a Competitive Natural Gas Supplier

Dear Mr. Cetola:

On April 24, 2013, Hess Energy Marketing, LLC (Hess Energy) filed with the Commission an application for registration as a competitive natural gas supplier (CNGS), together with the initial application fee of \$500.00. On May 8, 2013, Hess Energy filed revisions to its application.

Following its review of the filing, as revised, Commission Staff has determined that the application for registration as a CNGS meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02. The Commission, therefore, approves Hess Energy's application as a CNGS in the State of New Hampshire, with the registration to become effective May 29, 2013. This registration will expire at the end of business on May 28, 2018.

Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02(a), each CNGS shall re-register with the Commission by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of Hess Energy, on or before March 30, 2018. Please file a timely renewal application.

Registration instructions and a checklist of requirements to properly file a renewal registration application can be accessed from the Natural Gas Competition page of the Commission website (<http://puc.nh.gov/Gas-Steam/naturalgascompetition.htm>).

All registered CNGS entities in the State of New Hampshire are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3000 – Competitive Natural Gas Supplier and Aggregator Rules.
