and that the pipeline is constructed, op-erated, maintained and - if applicable -altered, consistent with Puc 506.02 and 49 CFR Part 192, as amended.

Based on the information presented in Liberty's petition and Staff's memoran-dum, the Commission has found that the proposed crossing is necessary for Liberty to meet the reasonable requirements of reliable service to the public and that the requested license may be exercised with-out substantially affecting the public rights in the affected waters, as required for approved under RSA 371:20. The peti-tion has been approved on a *nisi* basis, subject to public notice of the order and an

opportunity for public comment or hear-ing, to be effective as of a specified later date unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

Liberty is authorized by the Order Nisi to construct, maintain and operate a natural gas pipeline beneath the Succook River as described in its petition and depicted in its filings. All persons interested in re-sponding to the Order Nisi may submit their comments or file a written request for a hearing which states the reason and basis for a hearing no later than October 4, 2013 for the Commission's consideration; and any party interested in responding to such comments or request for a hearing dishall do so no later than October 11, 2013.
