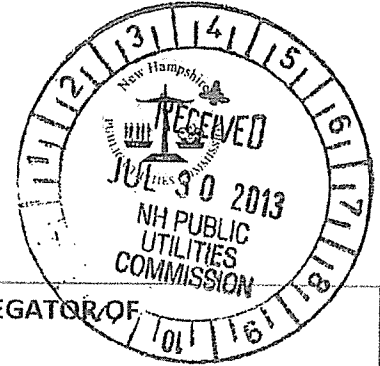

Pursuant to New Hampshire Administrative Code Puc 2506.01¹:




