

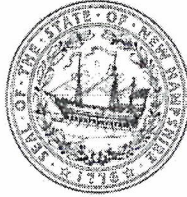

On November 13, 2013, RJT Energy Consultants, LLC (RJT Energy) submitted an application with the Commission to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. The application is incomplete and does not comply with the requirements of N.H. Code Admin. Rule Puc 2003. Commission Staff reviewed the filing and identified the following item which is missing from the application.

- 1) Certificate from the Secretary of State showing that the applicant is authorized to do business in New Hampshire is missing.

*Puc 2006.02 Form for Initial and Renewal of Aggregators.  
(5) A copy of the applicant's authorization to do business in New Hampshire from the secretary of state, if anything other than an individual.*

In order to complete your application you should respond accordingly to the item listed above. When responding, address your letter to Debra Howland, Executive Director, and reference the docket number listed on the subject line of this letter.
