Dear Ms. Lakritz:

On December 20, 2013, the Commission received an application from Knollwood Energy of MA, LLC (Knollwood Energy) requesting Class II New Hampshire REC eligibility for the O.R. Gooch & Sons, Inc. (O.R. Gooch) 0.0076 megawatt (MW) photovoltaic (PV) array located at 539 Calef Highway, Epping, NH.¹ The O.R. Gooch facility would participate in the Knollwood Energy aggregation pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard law.²

The Commission, in a non-adjudicative process, is required to issue a determination of whether a facility meets a particular classification within 45 days of receipt of a completed application. The above-named facility is a customer-sited source and meets the Class II eligibility requirements under RSA 362-F:4, II. Based on review of the application Staff recommends that the Commission approve the O.R. Gooch PV array as part of Knollwood Energy's aggregation effective December 20, 2013.

Since this facility is a customer-sited source, its output is not recorded in the ISO New England Market Settlement System and, as a result must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. The application states that Paul Button, Energy Audits Unlimited, will monitor the facility's output pursuant to N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08 and 2505.09. Mr. Button will report this facility's total output annually to the customer and to the

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Commission. The monthly output will be reported quarterly to the NEPOOL Generation Information System as part of Knollwood Energy's Class II aggregation pursuant to Puc 2505.09(h)(3). The GIS facility code assigned to O.R. Gooch is NON 38489.
