The Petition seeks a determination by the Commission as to whether Public Service of New Hampshire ("PSNH") is required by Rule Puc 2004.07(b)(1)b to have a provision in its tariff providing for "an off-cycle meter reading."

I understand that this issue is on the list of topics to be considered as part of the Puc 2000 rulemaking that is getting underway in Docket No. DRM 13-151.

Accordingly, PNE is hereby withdrawing the foregoing Petition without prejudice, subject to reinstating it, depending on the outcome of this issue in Docket No. DRM 13-151. The availability of an off-cycle meter reading, as is common elsewhere in New England, has become an important option given the price spikes that have occurred in the New England wholesale markets during recent winters.
