To the Parties:

The Commission held a prehearing conference in the above referenced matter on June 5, 2014. Appearances were entered by Public Service Company of New Hampshire, the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), and Commission Staff (Staff). The Commission's attorney, Michael Sheehan, presided as the Hearings Examiner and submitted a report with recommendations on June 13, 2014. Also present were Conservation Law Foundation (CLF) who filed a petition to intervene on June 3, 2014. The CLF petition is pending before the Commission.
