On October 20, 2014, the Commission received an application filed by Knollwood Energy of MA, LLC (Knollwood Energy) for Eaton Door and Frame (Eaton Door & Frame). Knollwood Energy is requesting Class II eligibility for Eaton Door & Frame's photovoltaic (PV) array expansion and continued inclusion in the Knollwood Energy aggregation. The Commission previously certified Eaton Door & Frame for a 0.03612 megawatt (MW) PV array effective as of June 4, 2014. The nameplate capacity for the system expansion is 0.018 for a total system nameplate capacity of 0.05412 MW.

The above-named facility is a customer-sited source and meets the Class II eligibility requirements under RSA 362-F:4, II. Based on review of the application, Staff recommends that the Commission certify the Eaton Door & Frame PV system expansion as an eligible facility for Class II RECs to be included as part of the Knollwood aggregation effective as of October 20, 2014.

Because this facility is a customer-sited source, its output is not recorded in the ISO New England Market Settlement System and, as a result must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. The application lists Thomas Kelly of Natural Capital, LLC as the independent monitor. The independent monitor's responsibility is to verify the facility's output pursuant to N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08 and 2505.09. Mr. Kelly will report this facility's total output annually to the customer and to the Commission. The monthly output will be reported quarterly to the NEPOOL Generation Information System as part of Knollwood Energy's Class II aggregation pursuant to Puc 2505.09(h)(3).

Please be advised that, pursuant to RSA 362-F, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission has certified the expanded Eaton Door and Frame (Eaton Door & Frame) photovoltaic (PV) facility as part of the Knollwood Energy of MA, LLC (Knollwood Energy) aggregation. The Commission previously certified Eaton Door & Frame for a 0.03612 megawatt (MW) PV array effective as of June 4, 2014. The nameplate capacity for the system expansion is 0.018 for a total system nameplate capacity of 0.05412 MW.
