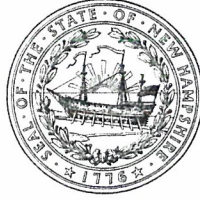

Dear Ms. Lakritz:

On July 31, 2014, the Commission received applications filed by Knollwood Energy of MA, LLC<sup>1</sup> (Knollwood Energy) for Shawn Houle (Houle), Greg Sowa (Sowa) and Brian Cook (Cook). Knollwood Energy is requesting Class II New Hampshire Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) eligibility for the Houle, Sowa, and Cook photovoltaic (PV) arrays<sup>2</sup> and inclusion in the Knollwood Energy aggregation.

The above-named facilities are customer-sited sources and all meet the Class II eligibility requirements under RSA 362-F:4, II. Based on review of the applications, Staff recommends that the Commission certify the Houle, Sowa, and Cook PV arrays as eligible facilities for Class II RECs and inclusion in the Knollwood aggregation effective as of July 31, 2014.

Since these facilities are customer-sited sources, the output is not recorded in the ISO New England Market Settlement System and, as a result must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. The application lists Paul Button of Energy Audits Unlimited as the independent monitor. The independent monitor's responsibility is to verify the facility's output pursuant to N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08 and 2505.09. Mr. Button will report the facilities' total output quarterly to the customer and to the NEPOOL Generation Information

<sup>2</sup> Pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard law. Class II eligibility requires a facility to produce electricity from solar technologies that began operation after January 1, 2006 (RSA 362-F:4, II).


System and annually to the Commission as part of the Knollwood Energy's Class II aggregation pursuant to Puc 2505.09(h)(3).

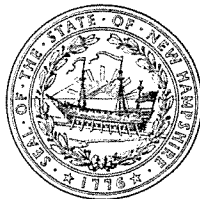

Please be advised that, pursuant to RSA 362-F, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission has certified the Shawn Houle (Houle), Greg Sowa (Sowa) and Brian Cook (Cook) photovoltaic (PV) arrays as part of the Knollwood Energy of MA, LLC (Knollwood Energy) aggregation.

Accordingly, Knollwood Energy is eligible to be issued Class II RECs, effective as of June 30, 2014 for the PV facilities summarized in the table below.
