Dear Director Howland:

Enclosed for filing in the above-captioned docket is a revised original and six copies of the Member Incentive for New Hampshire Electric Cooperative Inc.'s CORE Energy Efficiency programs operated from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015 as approved by the Commission in its Order No. 25,747 issued on September 11, 2015 in Docket No. DE 14-216.

The total earned incentive equals \$150,418, or 9.3% of actual expenditures. By sector, the portion of the budget resulting from performance in implementing the residential programs is \$90,870, or 9% of actual expenditures; performance in the commercial and industrial programs resulted in an incentive of \$59,548, or 10% of actual expenditures.

Also included is a report summarizing the difference between the total energy efficiency program funding and the expenses incurred in program year 2015. As shown, a balance of \$5,656 will be included in future CORE energy efficiency program year budgets.
