Dear Director Howland:

Please find enclosed for filing an original and six copies of the pre-filed testimony and technical statement of Christopher J. Goulding setting forth Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy's ("Eversource") request for an adjustment to the current Stranded Cost Recovery ("SCRC") rate effective on January 1, 2015 and approved by Order No. 25,742 (December 29, 2014). As described in Mr. Goulding's testimony, the proposed adjustment would result in an increase in the current average SCRC rate of 0.061 cents per kWh to an average rate of 0.171 cents per kWh to take effect from July 1 through December 31, 2015. This revised average SCRC rate is based on actual results through March 2015 and an updated forecast for the remainder of 2015. Eversource will update the rate with more up-to-date information in June 2015. Eversource is proposing the SCRC rate change to take effect July 1, 2015 consistent with its proposal to change the Energy Service rate, which is being filed contemporaneously.
