Dear Ms. Howland,

I received the request dated February 4, 2015 for additional information on the above-reference project. The information below should address your questions.

1. The project turbines are each rated at 2.85 MW, for a total project size of 34.2 MW. The turbine manufacturer, General Electric, originally offered this turbine model as a 2.75 MW turbine but updated it to 2.85 MW during our permitting process. If you see any outdated references to a 2.75 MW turbine in the application materials, please disregard them, as the project is using machines each rated at 2.85 MW.
2. A copy of an amendment to the project's interconnection agreement with ISO New England and Central Maine Power was submitted with the original application, but another copy is included with this letter for your convenience.
3. Energy New England is not an affiliate of Saddleback Ridge Wind, LLC. Saddleback has hired Energy New England to act as the lead market participant for the project with ISO New England. Energy New England also represents the entities purchasing power from the Saddleback Ridge Wind project and acts as a single point of contact for the offtakers in regards to the project.
