Re: Confidential Request for Waiver of Neustar's Denial for Numbering Resources

Dear Ms. Howland,

IDT America hereby seeks a waiver of Neustar's denial of numbering resources for Laconia, NH.

IDT is making this request for an additional block to support a service launched in May 2013 that permits business customers an option to port-in a range of sequential numbers or to request allocation of a new range of sequential numbers.

Within the two Laconia blocks currently held by IDT, not only are there a limited number of available telephone numbers, but also the current maximum length for a new range of sequential numbers is three. Business customers requesting a new range of sequential numbers exceeding three can only be served with current resources using multiple shorter ranges. An additional growth block for Laconia will provide the ability to fully serve such customers via one longer range of new sequential numbers.

The attached form (confidential treatment requested) illustrates a business customer's need for both ported-in and a range of new sequential numbers.
