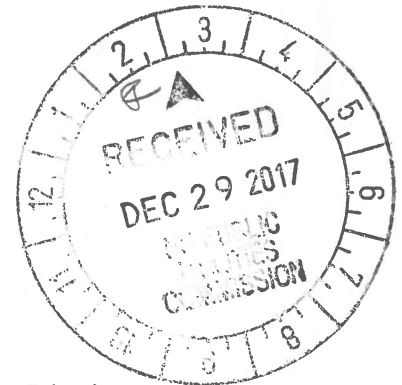

First Amended Wholesale Water Supply Contract

Dear Director Howland,

On July 28, 2015, in Order No. 25,800, the Commission approved a special contract between Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. ("PWW") and Tyngsborough Water District ("Tyngsborough"). On page 2 of the order, the Commission made note of a correction in the calculation of the total inch-feet that appeared in paragraph 6(c) of the contract. The rate was corrected from \$2.094 to \$2.101 per hundred cubic feet ("CCF"). The correction also affected the Base Monthly Fixed Fee in paragraph 6(b).

This change affected the signed proposed contract and necessitated PWW and Tyngsborough entering into an amended contract to reflect the correction approved by the Commission. The corrected contract is entitled: Wholesale Water Supply Contract-First Amendment and is attached for filing.
