Dear Ms. Howland:

TNCI Operating Company LLC submits to the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") an original and two (2) copies of revised Sheet Nos. 2 and 38 for incorporation into TNCI Operating Company LLC's ("TNCI OpCo") switched exchange access tariff, New Hampshire P.U.C. Tariff No. 3.

This submission is made pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, in Docket Nos. WC Docket No. 10-90, et al., FCC 11-161, Second Order on Reconsideration in Docket Nos. WC Docket No. 10-90, et al., FCC 12-47, and Sections 51.911 and 61.26(c) of the FCC's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§51.911, 61.26(c).

By this submission TNCI OpCo adopts the interstate access rates set forth in the Fairpoint Telephone Companies Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 31, filed on June 16, 2015 and effective on July 1, 2015 for its intrastate terminating switched exchange access and originating and terminating Voice over Internet Protocol – Public Switched Telephone Network Traffic rates. TNCI OpCo requests a July 1, 2015 effective date to comply with the above cited orders and rules. The Company's F.C.C. ³ Pursuant to Section 61.26(c), "The benchmark rate for a CLEC's switched exchange access services will be the rate charged for similar services by the competing ILEC. If an ILEC to which a CLEC benchmarks its rates, pursuant to this section, lowers the rate to which a CLEC benchmarks, the CLEC must revise its rates to the lower level within 15 days of the effective date of the lowered ILEC rate."
