Re: DW 15-199 Abenaki Water Company's ("Abenaki" or "Company") requested One-time Sewer Surcharge Recoupment

Dear Ms. Howland:

In accordance with PUC Order No. 26,223 dated February 28, 2019 "Abenaki-Lakeland Sewer May implement a surcharge to recoup revenues necessary to pay the invoiced municipal sewer charges incurred between December 1, 2018 and the date of this order; and it is FURTHER ORDERED, that Abenaki shall file within 30 days of the date of this order, documentation of the uncollected revenues, that went into effect December 1, 2018, and file the proposed surcharge for recovering the uncollected revenues from customers.

The Company is requesting a one-time surcharge specific to each customer based on their actual usage for December 2018 and January 2019 as well as the difference between base fee charged and approved base charge. The one-time surcharge for each customer proposed is less than the original rate case expense surcharge approved for each customer in the original case.

In support of the Company's proposed surcharge, the Company is providing a summary outlining the surcharge applicable to each customer in Attachment A. The Attachment outlines the actual usage by each customer, identifies what was billed and what should be billed as well as the base charge that was billed and what should have been billed.
