
Dear Ms. Howland:

The original and six (6) copies of this letter are herewith being filed in connection with the above docket.  
The purpose of this letter is to clarify the project relative to following items;

- a. Rights – Structure #20W2/2 on the southwest side of the crossing is located on fee owned property (tax map 113, lot 17), structure #1/18X is located in the Lake Street right of way, and the wire between the two structures crosses over tax map 113, lot 20 through the benefit of an easement. A copy of the respective deed and easement are attached with this letter. The licensing for structure #1/18X is pending. When completed it will be license #41-0546. Because this is a shared pole, the license document was sent to Fairpoint for signature on January 15, 2016. Once it is received back from Fairpoint it will be mailed to the Town for their approval and recording.
- b. NESC – The NESC reference in item 5 of the original filing cited the 2007 code. This item should be corrected to cite the current code, the 2012 version.
