I am writing with an update on our response to your letter of July 28, 2015 requesting additional information to the Competitive Electric Power Supplier Application of Reliant Energy Northeast LLC ("Reliant").

- 1) Enclosed is a letter from the New Hampshire Secretary of State confirming the registration of the trade names "NRG Business" and "NRG Retail Solutions."
- 2) Reliant is in the process of scheduling EDI testing with Eversource. We expect to complete EDI testing by November. At that time we will provide the Commission proof of EDI testing pursuant to the requirements of Puc 2003. 01(d)(1).
