Dear Ms. Howland:

Reliant Energy Northeast LLC (“Reliant”) respectfully requests a waiver of Puc 2003.01 (h) as well as an extension of the Commission’s review of the company’s Competitive Electric Power Supplier Application for the reason described below.

Reliant is in the process of conducting EDI testing with Eversource. Eversource is unable to guarantee that the EDI testing will be completed by November 25, 2015. Reliant and Eversource expect to complete testing within the next three weeks. Accordingly, Reliant requests an extension on its Electric Power Supplier Application to December 18, 2015. Upon completion of EDI testing Reliant will provide the Commission proof of EDI testing pursuant to the requirements of Puc 2003. 01(d)(1).
