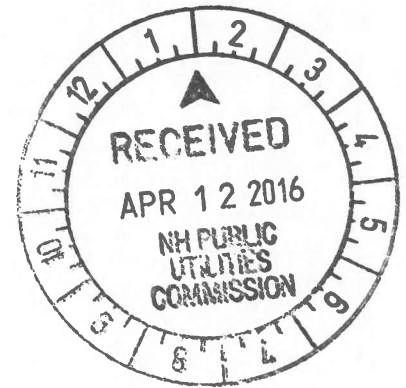

Dear Secretary Howland,

As required in NHPUC Order 23,980 dated May 30, 2002, and the Electric Assistance Procedures Manuals, attached are the following monthly reports for March 2016 on Eversource's Electric Assistance Program (EAP):

1. EAP System Benefits Charge (SBC) Reconciliation;
2. Number of active EAP participants and participation levels by discount tier and discount amounts per tier; and,
3. Aging comparison between EAP and other residential accounts.

A report of the actual EAP administrative costs is also provided for quarter ending March 31, 2016.

Additionally, on April 5, 2016, the Program Administrator was provided customer billing, and payment information via File Transfer Protocol (FTP) as required by the Procedures Manuals.

For the month of March 2016, Eversource expenses were \$212,837.78 above the Net SBC Funding. The net cumulative amount remitted by the State Treasury for PSNH program expenditures since inception stands at \$10,689,596.51.
