On March 22, 2016, Direct Energy Business, LLC (Direct Energy Business), a competitive electric power supplier currently authorized to operate in the franchise areas of New Hampshire Electric Cooperative, Inc. and Liberty Utilities, filed a request to expand its service territory to include the franchise area of Public Service Company of New Hampshire, d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource). Direct Energy Business provided a copy of a certificate demonstrating that it had completed electronic data interchange (EDI) testing with Eversource.

Staff reviewed the information in the request and believes Direct Energy Business's filing meets the requirements to extend its service territory into the franchise area of Eversource. Staff, therefore, recommends that the Commission approve Direct Energy Business's request to include the franchise area of Eversource in its service territory.
