MR. FOSSUM: Yes. Consistent with what we've done historically relating to our Stranded — the Company's Stranded Cost Recovery Charge, we have filed for a proposed Stranded Cost Recovery Charge rate for effect on January 1, 2016. It's been calculated and presented in much the same way as it has historically been done.

I suppose, really, the only matter that's a little bit different in this one is that, in the Company's last reconciliation docket, DE 14-120, the Commission had issued an order relative to the recoupment of certain rate reduction bond costs. The recoupment of those funds, of those costs, is included in this calculation consistent with the Commission's order.

And, with that said, we look forward to working with the Staff and the OCA to go over any issues in the docket, and including the one that I've just described.

And, consistent with past practice, we will be updating this rate close to the date of the hearing, and at that time would ask for a permanent rate for the -- that the Commission approve then a permanent rate for effect on January 1, 2016. Thank you.
