REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF 120-DAY RESPONSE PERIOD AND WAIVER OF PUC 2003.01(h) FOR DM 15-478, EVERYDAY ENERGY, LLC D/B/A ENERGY REWARDS COMPETITIVE ELECTRIC POWER SUPPLIER APPLICATION

Everyday Energy, LLC d/b/a Energy Rewards ("Energy Rewards") formally requests that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission formally extend the 120-day response period and waive Puc 2003.01(h) in regards to its Competitive Electric Power Supplier Application, DM 15-478.

Energy Rewards requests an extension of an additional 50 days following the previous expiration date of March 11, 2016. This extension would provide a new expiration date of April 30, 2016.

Energy Rewards shall file an update to the status of all responses in the initially filed application to address any material changes from the date the applications were originally filed. This includes responses to application questions regarding states in which Energy Rewards currently conducts business, all complaints, and any convictions of applicant principals.

Energy Rewards is aware of all items still listed as deficient and required to complete the application including revision of the surety bond incorporating an expiration date no sooner than one year and seven (7) business days after the projected date that all EDI testing and training is completed.

Energy Rewards requests the extension and waiver as it is still awaiting testing start dates from Eversource (PSNH) in regards to its EDI Certification due to PSNH vendor issues with the testing system.
