On May 6, 2016, the Commission approved a petition filed irsuant to RSA 371:17 by Green Mountain Power Corporation (GMP), requesting a license to upgrade and maintain electric lines over and across three locations on the Sugar River in Claremont, New Hampshire.

New poles and electric lines are necessary to better serve customers. The existing lines were constructed over 50 years ago. The transmission line segments are an integral part of GMP's transmission system and the overall New England transmission grid. The electric lines are necessary to meet the reasonable requirements of service to the public.
