On February 23, 2016, Diversegy, LLC (Diversegy) filed an application to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. Diversegy's currently effective registration expires on April 10, 2016.

Staff has reviewed the application and has determined that the filing is complete. Staff noted that that, pursuant to Puc 2003.05(a), Diversegy's renewal application should have been filed at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration, on or before February 10, 2016. Because this is the first time Diversegy has been late with its submission to renew its registration for electric load aggregation, Staff recommends the Commission approve Diversegy's renewal application to provide electric load aggregation service, effective April 10, 2016, for a term of five years.
