Concord Steam has submitted a usage rate case filing and is requesting a waiver from the 30 day notice period. We originally sent in an electronic Notice of Intent to File for our rate case filing on February 3, 2016, but the paper copy was inadvertently not filed. We discovered this on March 8 and the Notice of Intent to File was resubmitted in paper and electronically.
