Dear Director Howland:

On December 9, 2016, consistent with the procedural schedule in the docket, Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource") submitted the Technical Statement and updated exhibits of David F. Bidmead to explain the major changes to proposed Stranded Cost Recovery Charge ("SCRC") rate from what had been submitted on September 30, 2016. On December 7, 2016, the December Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative ("RGGI") auction was held, and the results of that auction became available on December 9 and were used in calculating the RGGI rate shown on Exhibit DFB-3, page 1 of 4. However, when incorporating the results of the auction into Exhibit DFB-3, page 4 of 4, there was a calculation error that resulted in incorrect totals appearing in Column 6 of that Exhibit. To correct that error, Eversource provides with this letter an updated version of Exhibit DFB-3, page 4 of 4, with the correct calculations. This update has no impact on the calculated SCRC or RGGI rates shown on Exhibit DFB-1, page 1 as filed on December 9, 2016.
