On behalf of Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp., d/b/a Liberty Utilities, I write to inform the Commission that, as promised in the Company's "status report" filed on December 7, 2018, the Company has provided its "final comprehensive response" to the Safety Division's October 5, 2018, evaluation of the Company's temporary CNG facility in Keene.

Attached is the Company's February 22, 2019, cover letter to the Safety Division which provides an overview of the Company's response. Also attached is the spreadsheet previously filed with the Company's December 2018 status report that has been updated to describe the steps taken in response to the Safety Division's evaluation.
