Service shall consists of the production, treatment, and distribution of water for all residential, commercial and industrial requirements of customers whose premises abut any public street, road or way in which the Company has mains; provided, however, that such service shall only be rendered pursuant to the Terms and Conditions prescribed in other sections of this Tariff and the Rules of New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission for Water Service.

Capital Recovery Surcharge:

A capital recovery surcharge shall be made for each customer whom service is rendered under this tariff, based on the meter size shown below:

The surcharge will be charged monthly over a period of 30 years to the record holder where the existing service is provided. The surcharge will be calculated in each general rate case to reflect the current number of customers in each system.

Terms of Payment:

Bills under this rate are net; will be rendered monthly, and are due and payable at the office of the Company on the due date as stated on the water bill.
