Dear Ms. Howland:

Section 4.3, Bates page 35, of the 2018-2020 NH Statewide Energy Efficiency Plan approved by the Commission in its Order No. 26,095 dated January 2, 2018 in Docket DE 17-136 states: "The NH Utilities shall provide notification to the Commission if an individual program's actual expenditures are forecasted to exceed 120 percent of the program's budget."

Eversource expects that spending for the Home Energy Assistance program in 2019 will be \$7,295,396 or 121% of the original budget. To cover this increase, Eversource plans to utilize \$800,880 from ENERGY STAR Homes program and \$479,409 from the Home Performance with ENERGY STAR Program. When viewed in total, Eversource anticipates spending for the Residential sector will be just above the planned total sector budget of \$16,475,810

Eversource has been working closely with the Community Action Agencies to ramp up the HEA program and had several large projects that were close to completion during December of 2019. The spending estimates included in this letter are based on recent analysis of which invoices will be reflected on the General Ledger for the 2019 Program year. Final 2019 expenditures for all programs will be summarized in the 2019 Performance Incentive filing due by June 1, 2020. Debra A. Howland January 16, 2020 Page 2
