On behalf of Liberty Utilities' (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities, I write to provide a corrected Page 22 "Terms and Conditions" in the Electric Delivery Service Tariff – NHPUC No. 20. The correction made clarifies that Order No. 26,323 in Docket No. DE 17-136 Electric and Gas Utilities 2018–2020 New Hampshire Statewide Energy Efficiency Plan approves the rate of 0.528¢ collected through the Energy Efficiency portion of the System Benefits Charge. Also, language regarding the Lost Base Revenue portion of the System Benefits Charge has been removed to closer align with Order No. 26,323.

In Order No. 26,323, the Commission approved the request for the System Benefits Charge rate associated with the Company's Electric Energy Efficiency Programs effective January 1, 2020. This rate change results in an increase of 0.79%, or \$0.93 for a residential customer taking energy service using 650 kilowatt-hours per month.
