In compliance with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission's ("Commission") Secretarial Letter filed on June 11, 2021 in Docket No. DE 17-136, please find attached for filing with the Commission Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy's revised performance incentive calculation relating to the NHSaves Energy Efficiency Programs for program year 2020. This revision reflects the adjustment to cap the C&I Demand Response expenditures at \$456,224.87, or 120%, within the performance incentive calculation and its associated impact on the 2020 reconciliation, corrects the planned Smart Start amount in the 2020 Plan page to the proper dollar figure of \$30,000, as listed in Attachment D of the 2020 Plan Update filed on January 15, 2020 and conforms the program naming convention of the 2020 Actuals page with the 2020 Plan page of the report for consistency and to avoid confusion.
