On September 27, 2017, Ameresco, Inc. submitted an application with the Commission to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. Staff reviewed the application and determined that it is complete.

Commission Staff filed a memorandum on October 4, 2017 recommending that the Commission approve the renewal registration for a five-year term beginning on December 6, 2017.

The Commission has approved the application for registration renewal effective as of December 6, 2017. The renewed registration is for a term of five years and expires at the close of business on December 5, 2022. Pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2003.05(a), you must submit your next renewal application at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the registration approved here, on or before October 7, 2022.

Please be aware that registered providers of electric aggregation service are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2000 – Competitive Electric Power Supplier and Aggregator Rules. These rules are available at: <u>http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Rules/PUC2000.pdf</u>. Please also be aware that revised Puc 2000 rules, which were adopted on August 25, 2017, and become effective on November 1, 2017, contain certain requirements that are different from those in the currently effective rules.
