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
**Re: DE 17-165, Abenaki Water Company, Inc.
Withdrawal of Motion for Rehearing**

Dear Ms. Howland:

As pointed out in the letter filed by Ms. Ross yesterday in the above-captioned proceeding, the parties have agreed to amend the May 30, 2018 Settlement Agreement—Temporary Rates, changing the effective date for temporary rates to May 1, 2018. Ms. Ross also noted that Omni Mount Washington Hotel, LLC agreed to withdraw the motion for rehearing it had filed on August 13, 2018, with respect to Order No. 26,157 (July 13, 2018). This letter follows up on Omni's agreement to withdraw its motion for rehearing in light of the amendment to the Settlement Agreement.
