Deficiency Letter – Request for Additional Information

Dear Mr. Praeger:

On November 30, 2017, AvidXchange, Inc. submitted an application to the Commission to register as a provider of electric aggregation service. Commission Staff has reviewed the application and determined it is incomplete and therefore does not comply with the requirements of N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2003. In particular, Staff identified the following requirement that has not been met and the related item which is missing from the application:

1) Either a) a recent printout of applicant's listing on the N.H. Secretary of State website with the status shown as "Good Standing" or words of similar import or b) a certificate from the Secretary of State (SOS) showing that the applicant is authorized to do business in New Hampshire.

Puc 2006.02 Information Required for Initial and Renewal Registration of Aggregators.

(f) Evidence of the applicant's authorization to do business in New Hampshire from the New Hampshire secretary of state, if anything other than an individual.

In order to complete your application, you should respond accordingly to the item listed above. When responding, please address your letter to Debra A. Howland, Executive Director, and reference the docket number listed on the subject line of this letter.

Pursuant to Puc 2003.05(f), please provide all information requested within 60 days of the date of this later, on or before **February 2, 2018**. Puc 2003.05(f) is copied below.

Puc 2003.05 Registration of Aggregators.

(f) The commission shall reject an application for aggregator registration when information required to complete such registration is not provided within 60 days of request for such information.
