Dear Ms. Howland:

As directed by the Commission's April 20, 2020, secretarial letter issued in Docket No. DG 17-152, I write on behalf of Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. to propose a procedural schedule in DG 17-152 that contains a single event -- a June 3, 2020, technical session at which the Company will provide an update to the parties and at which the parties will develop a more complete procedural.

I also write to propose the same procedural schedule in Docket No. DG 17-198, which the Commission "suspended until further notice" by secretarial letter of October 18, 2019.

As indicated in the Company's April 17, 2020, status report in DG 17-152, the Company "has reached a point in its work on the issues impacting the LCIRP ... and which issues are also related to the Granite Bridge project in DG-17-198, such that we can begin developing a proposed procedural schedule."

The Company circulated to all parties in both dockets the proposed June 3 technical session as described above. All who have been active in the dockets have affirmatively assented to the schedule (Commission Staff, the Office of the Consumer Advocate, Conservation Law

Foundation, Pipeline Awareness Network, and Terry Clark). No party from either docket indicated an objection to the schedule.

As a condition for assenting to this request, the Company was asked to agree not to argue such assent constitutes a party's agreement to, or waiver of, anything further in these dockets. Liberty hereby makes that agreement.

The Company thus asks the Commission to schedule a June 3, 2020, technical session in both dockets above.
