Summary

On March 12, 2021, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (Unitil or Company) filed a proposal to reduce the Storm Recovery Adjustment Factor (SRAF) from \$0.00084 per kWh to \$0.00047 per kWh effective May 1, 2021, reflecting the end of the three year period of recovery of the costs associated with the October 2017 Wind Storm as approved by Order No. 26,123.

Accordingly, Staff has reviewed the proposed reduction of the SRAF effective May 1, 2021, and recommends approval of the Company's proposed reduction and the revisions to Pages 4, 5, 6 and 69 of its tariff for an effective date of May 1, 2021.

Background

On March 12, 2021, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (Unitil or Company) filed a proposal to reduce the Storm Recovery Adjustment Factor (SRAF) from \$0.00084 per kWh to \$0.00047 per kWh effective May 1, 2021, reflecting the end of the three year period of recovery of the costs associated with the October 2017 Wind Storm as approved by Order No. 26,123. Based on this change, a typical residential customer on Default Service using 650 kWh per month will see a bill decrease of (\$0.24) or (0.2%) compared to current rates. Unitil is currently expecting a balance of approximately \$56,319 at the end of April 2021 associated with this recovery. Per its tariff, Unitil will file the final results of its recovery with the Commission no later than sixty days after the conclusion of the recovery period of April 30, 2021, with the disposition of any remaining balance subject to Commission review and approval.

Analysis and Recommendation

Staff requested updated calculation increments of the SRAF consistent with Docket No. DE 18-036 in Exhibit 1¹ on Bates pages 68 through 70 (Schedule DLC-6), and with Docket No. DE 19-043 in Exhibit 1² on Bates pages 26 through 28 (Schedule TRD-3). Staff received this updated calculation shown in Attachment RTC-1³ on March 17, 2021 as requested. Staff has reviewed this updated calculation, confirmed the three-year recovery period of the costs of the October 2017 Wind Storm as approved by Order No. 26,123, and the proposed reduction of the SRAF effective May 1, 2021.

Staff recommends approval of Unitil's proposed reduction of the SRAF effective May 1, 2021, as approved by Order No. 26,123. Staff also recommends approval of the Company's proposed revisions to Pages 4, 5, 6 and 69 of its tariff for an effective date of May 1, 2021.
