Modifying Period of Registration as Competitive Electric Power Supplier

Dear Ms. Clay:

By secretarial letter dated April 16, 2018, the competitive electric power supplier (CEPS) registration of Viridian Energy, LLC (Viridian Energy) was renewed for a period coterminous with the expiration of its financial security instrument, beginning on May 31, 2018 and ending on May 31, 2019.

Based on a review of our records, we have determined that Viridian Energy's renewal registration should have been approved for a period of three (3) years, consistent with N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2003.02(f). Accordingly, Viridian Energy's renewed registration as a CEPS is hereby modified to end at the close of business on May 31, 2021. Pursuant to Puc 2003.02(a), Viridian Energy must submit its next renewal application at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the approved registration period, on or before April 1, 2021.

Please note that, under Puc 2003.03(e), if a CEPS's financial security instrument will not be renewed or extended beyond its expiration date, it must (1) provide written notice to the Commission of such non-renewal or non-extension no less than 60 days prior to the expiration date, and (2) file with the Executive Director a replacement financial security instrument meeting the requirements of the rules no less than 30 days prior to the expiration date. Under Puc 2003.03(f), a CEPS that fails to comply with the requirement to file a replacement financial security instrument is subject to fines, suspension, or revocation pursuant to Puc 2005.
