Dear Ms. Howland:

On June 27, 2018, the Commission issued an order granting Twin Pines Housing's request for a waiver of N.H. Code Admin Rule Puc 303.02, the Commission's master metering rule. The waiver pertains to TPH's 29-unit affordable multi-family residential building, currently under construction.

In our original request, we stated that there would be one master meter for the project. As our plans have become more detailed, the design has changed. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the updated meter configuration plan.

The updated plan calls for three General Service Rate G-3 meters. Each meter would provide service separately for each of the three floors of the facility. This is for individual residential units and common areas on each floor.

The updated plans also call for one General Long Hour Service Rate G-2 meter to service the elevator, hot water heaters and mechanical loads.

It is our understanding that this explanation will become a record within the docket and that no further action will be required. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
