Reconciliation of Energy Service and Stranded Costs for Calendar Year 2017

Dear Director Howland:

On June 1, 2018, Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource") filed its annual reconciliation of Energy Service and Stranded Costs for Calendar Year 2017. Included in that submission, as Exhibit 1, were the testimony and attachments of Christopher J. Goulding describing the accounting for, and reconciliation of, the relevant costs. Included in that testimony and attachments was information relating to the incorporation of the results of a recently completed lead/lag study. Through the process of discovery in the docket certain adjustments and updates to that study were identified.

Given the nature of the updates to the lead/lag study and the corresponding changes to the reconciliation calculations, Eversource determined, following consultation with the Commission Staff, that the most appropriate means to address the identified adjustments and updates was to submit a revised version of Exhibit 1. Accordingly, included with this submission is an updated version of Exhibit 1 addressing and incorporating the changes to the lead/lag study made during the discovery process. For the pages in Attachments CJG-4, CJG-5, and CJG-6 that have been updated, the individual pages have been noted as being updated and the updated information has been highlighted in yellow to allow for easier identification.

Eversource requests that the Commission accept this revised Exhibit 1 in place of the original Exhibit 1 in preparation for the hearing on this matter scheduled for January 10, 2019. Thank you for your cooperation. Please do not hesitate to contact me with any questions.
