Petition for Approval of Franchise Expansion in the Town of Londonderry and Approval of MSDC Rates for Lorden Commons

Summary of Order *Nisi* No. 26,255 Approving Petition

June 7, 2019

On June 7, 2019, the Commission approved the expansion of the Town of Derry's water franchise to a limited area of the Town of Londonderry known as Lorden Commons, and the existing residential area surrounding the proposed water main extension from Derry. All new customers in the proposed franchise area will be assessed the same rates, charges, and fees for service as those applied to Derry's municipal customers, with the exception of the Merrimack Source Development Charge (MSDC), which will be more than 15 percent higher than the MSDC paid by Derry residents. The Commission authorized Derry to charge higher MSDC rates to the customers in the new franchise area and exempted Derry from further Commission regulation.

The Commission delayed the effectiveness of its order to ensure that interested persons and the public receive notice of the Commission's determination and have an opportunity to file comments or request a hearing. All persons interested in responding to the order may submit their comments or file a written request for a hearing, which states the reason and basis for a hearing, no later than June 24, 2019. Any person(s) responding to such comments and request for hearing shall do so no later than July 1, 2019.
