## Dear Director Howland:

Pursuant to the Commission's Secretarial Letter dated September 5, 2019, this letter is to update the Commission on the status of the Town of Londonderry's zoning board of adjustment's ("ZBA") local approval of the water tank project.

In light of the ZBA denial of Pennichuck East Utility, Inc.'s ("PEU") application for a variance for the water storage tank, PEU and Pillsbury Realty Development, LLC are revising the tank project to address the local concerns. PEU will be filing that revised project with the Commission in the very near future. The new tank will slightly change the cost figures of the approved special contract, however, there will be no change to the cost sharing formula approved in Order No. 26,285 such that the parties believe the special contract remains consistent with the public interest.
