This follows up on Staff's letter of July 31, 2018 in the above-referenced docket, as well as the August 24, 2018 memorandum from the Commission's Safety Division. The July 31 letter, subsequent to the prehearing conference and technical session of July 24, 2018, noted that Staff would be filing a substantive recommendation by the end of August, after which the parties would make recommendations on how to proceed with this docket.

The Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA) is concerned about the issues raised in the Safety Division's memorandum. According to the Safety Division, Unitil has been serving some 20 customers in Atkinson for the past 28 years without the requisite franchise authority. We agree with the Safety Division that this revelation raises issues about the Company's compliance with applicable statutes and regulations in a manner that makes it inadvisable for the Commission to resolve this docket via an order *nisi*. Accordingly, we believe there should be formal discovery, an opportunity for Staff and the OCA to submit prefiled testimony, and ultimately an evidentiary hearing in this proceeding. We would welcome the opportunity to discuss such a schedule with Staff and Unitil prior to its adoption by the Commission.
