SUBJECT: DM 18-172, Agera Energy, LLC Competitive Electric Power Supplier Withdrawal of Registration

On June 5, 2020, Agera Energy, LLC (Agera) filed a letter seeking to withdraw its registration as a competitive electric power supplier (CEPS).

In that letter, Agera noted that, pursuant to an order issued by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court in the Southern District of New York, Agera had either transferred all of its New Hampshire electric supply customers to Constellation New Energy, Inc. or returned them to utility default service. As of February 27, 2020, Agera ceased to serve customers in New Hampshire, according to the letter.

Staff in the Consumer Services Division has confirmed that there are no pending customer complaints against Agera. Agera has therefore met all of the conditions for voluntary withdrawal of its CEPS registration under N.H. Admin. R., Puc 2003.08. Accordingly, Staff recommends that the Commission approve Agera's request to voluntarily withdraw its registration as a CEPS, and that Agera be released from its related financial security obligations.

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
